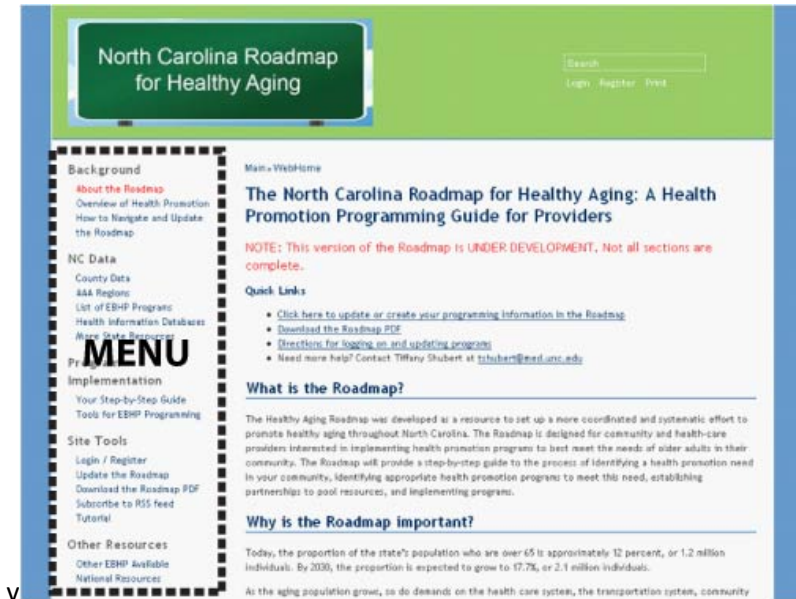


# How to Use This Site

## I. Accessing and registering on the NC Roadmap

1. Go to [www.ncroadmap.org](http://www.ncroadmap.org)
2. To navigate the site, use the menu along the left hand side



3. To search for a particular program, go to the search menu at the upper right hand corner of the site

4. To update or enter new information, you need to register as a user, or log on to the site if you are already registered. To do this, select either log on or register from the upper right hand menu.

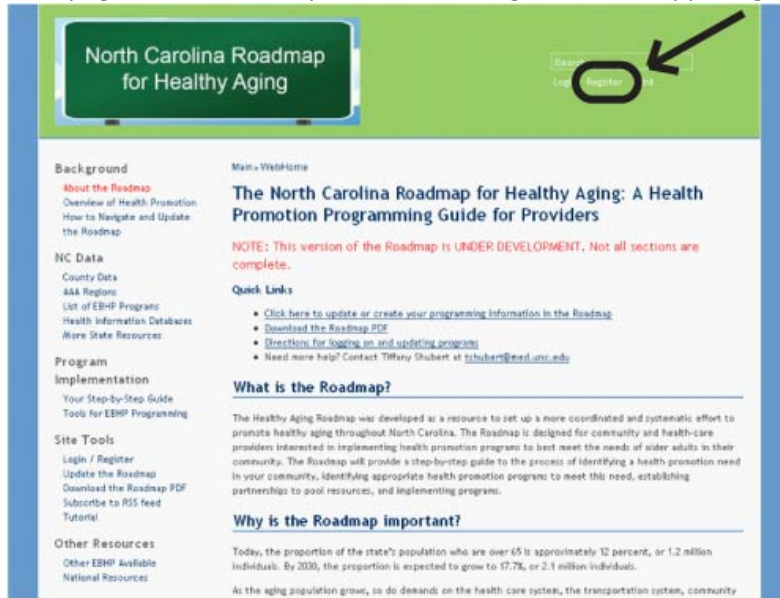


## To Register as a new user

#### What is the Roadmap?

The Healthy Aging Roadmap was developed as a resource to set up a more coordinated and systematic effort to promote healthy aging throughout North Carolina. The Roadmap is designed for community and health-care providers interested in implementing health promotion programs to best meet the needs of older adults in their community. The Roadmap will provide a step-by-step guide to the process of identifying a health promotion need in your community, identifying appropriate health promotion programs to meet this need, establishing partnerships to pool resources, and implementing programs.

#### Why is the Roadmap important?

Today, the proportion of the state's population who are over 65 is approximately 12 percent, or 1.2 million individuals. By 2030, the proportion is expected to grow to 17.7%, or 2.1 million individuals.
